A normal Christian **goes** to church...

A radical Christian **IS** the church and goes to people!

ANC believes Jesus **gave** His life...

ARC believes Jesus **IS** his life!

ANC is **content** with Christ...

ARC is **consumed** with Christ!

ANC loves those who **help** them...

ARC loves those who **hate** them!

ANC prays for **safety** and **security**...

ARC prays *whatever the cost* Lord, may Your kingdom come
and your will be done *whether I'm safe and secure or not!*

ANC prays, "Meet my needs."

ARC prays, "Use me to meet the needs of the poor
and the deprived and the destitute."

ANC is focused on **making the most of the days in his schedule**...

ARC is only focused on **two days, *this day and that day!*** This
day that I have right now and that day when I stand before Him!
